Note 1: The above is the list of produce we have planted in the past. Each year we buy these seeds but may not get to plant all of them. Due to weather, time or ground space limitations when a specific plant should be put out a few varieties may not get planted but typically there is more than enough variety.

Note 2: not all produce will be successful each season. Boxes will only contain a selection of what is ready at the time of harvest. Due to favorable weather some produce may span more than one season even if not listed in that season.

Note 3: The real value of this list is to indicate what you cannot expect in your box. For example, there are no tomatoes in winter.
